ADOPTING PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Board of Trustees of Batavia Township, Clermont County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 12th day of July, 2022 at the Batavia Township Community Center with the following members present:

Trustee Parsons moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Batavia Township Board of Trustees is authorized to adopt rules and regulations for the government and control of township parks pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 511.32 and 755.13; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to adopt such rules and regulations for the Batavia Township Community Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Batavia Township, Clermont County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Board of Trustees hereby adopts the rules and regulations attached hereto as Exhibit A for the Batavia Township Community Park pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 511.32 and 755.13.

SECTION 2. The Board does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to Section 504.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 3 . That this Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest time allowed by law.



BATAVIA TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY PARK
RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Township Park will be open to the general public between the hours of sunrise to sunset. No person shall remain and/or use the Park or Park facilities after closing time unless the Board has granted specific written permission.
2. Cans, bottles, and all other waste materials must be placed in trash containers.
3. No person shall drive, propel or park any motor vehicle, mini-bike, motorcycle, or other motorized vehicles on the grass or walking trail. Parking is permitted only in designated parking areas. Overnight parking is not permitted, except as specifically authorized by the Board. Any unauthorized vehicle in the Park after the closing time will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
4. No person shall start a fire or use fireworks in the Park.
5. Alcoholic beverages (including beer in cans and bottles) are prohibited at all times. Non-alcoholic beverages in glass containers are also prohibited.
6. Smoking or vaping is prohibited at all times.
7. No person shall, either by word or act, indulge in any noisy, boisterous, disorderly, or indecent conduct or in any manner disturb the peace or good of the community within the Park.
8. Unleashed dogs and other pets are prohibited in the Park. Dogs on a leash are permitted, provided the owner assumes responsibility for picking up and disposing of the dog's excrement. Unleashed dogs are permitted in the designated dog park.
9. Overnight camping and parking in the Park is prohibited.
10. No person shall use a skateboard or like object in the park.
11. No person shall possess, obtain or use a controlled substance within the Park, as defined by Section 3917.10 of the Ohio Revised Code. No person shall sniff, breathe, nor otherwise use in any way other than the intended use by the manufacturer any product containing a harmful intoxicant as defined by Section 2925.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.
12. No child under 12 years old shall be left unattended in any area of the Park. Anyone using the playground equipment does so at their own risk.
13. No person shall operate within the Park any flying drone or other unmanned aircraft systems.
14. No person shall swim in the pond.
15. If fishing, the pond is catch and release only.
