CALL TO ORDER

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Parsons introduced a member of our business community, KangaRoof, located at 117 E. Main Street, Amelia. It is owned by Duane Brandstetter who gave an overview of his services. A plaque was presented to KangaRoof for their outstanding service and willingness to provide volunteer services to organizations in need. They are a valuable member of the Batavia Township business community.

Mr. Parsons introduced Matt Miller, Boy Scout, and his father Steve. He is working on his Eagle Scout.

Dean Greg Sojka spoke about the Reds Rookie Success League and the field renovations fund. He suggested this would benefit the community, its youth, and Clermont College. Present with Dean Sojka was Jack Harbison, assistant baseball coach.

Mr. Steve Miller, Beechwood Place, spoke concerning issues with the creek behind his home and neighbors’ homes. This may be an HOA issue. Mr. Parsons will speak with the appropriate County agency to address this.

REPORTS OF THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR

Mrs. Kelley presented copies of her report to the Trustees. A commercial use permit was issued to IRG for Global Scrap Management, an aluminum recycling business.

There was some discussion about the nuisance code and violations. The grass on the property on State Route 132 was cut and will need to be cut again. **Resolution 10-2-2011** will be discussed at the next meeting.

The Board of Appeals heard one case on September 15th. There are two hearings scheduled on October 20th. The Zoning Commission will hear a case on October 13th.

DEPUTY REPORT

Deputy Nick Goslin gave the Batavia Township report for the Sheriff’s office. There were 460 calls answered, 101 offense reports, 103 incident reports, and 53 warrants served. There were 31 adult arrests and 8 juvenile arrests. There were 28 traffic arrests and 30 traffic warnings. There were 3 OVI’s. There were numerous vehicle break-ins.

REPORTS OF THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR

Mr. Parsons announced we received approval for the FEMA funds through the historical section of FEMA. They determined the bridge is not of historical value, therefore the bridge repair project is moving along.

The concession/restroom facility is continuing in its completion. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony on Wednesday, November 2nd at noon at the Community Center.

The request from the County Commissioners was withdrawn for the Batavia Village annexation for the Wiedenbein property. Another petition was received today for the same property. Discussion ensued. Mr. Sauls motioned the Batavia Township Trustees seek council to pursue options in the Batavia annexation. Mr. Dowdney seconded the motion. On the roll being called:

Mr. Parsons informed the Trustees this is the second year for reserving the picnic shelter. So far this year there have been 77 reservations. There are various activities that enhance the shelter including basketball, corn hole, and volleyball.

House Bill 246 (Reverse Auctions) is being proposed to reverse the bidding process, where prices will start high and go low instead of low going high. This will affect every type of bidding.

The approved electric aggregation will be over at the end of the year. Residents can profit from this option.

The renewal for health insurance is January 1st. Mr. Parsons will obtain information from the Trustees so he can get prices from local vendors.

Clermont County has asked for the Ohio EPA to develop a closure plan for the CECOS landfill operation, now owned by Republic Services. The facility is closed but this would continue the monitoring of the facility. Mr. Parsons explained if the Trustees pass a resolution in support of the County, it will support the County's request for a closure plan. We will be asking the EPA to follow what the County is suggesting.

Mr. Sauls motioned the Batavia Township Trustees adopt **Resolution 10-3-2011** supporting the County's closure plan in followup of the Aber Road Landfill. Mr. Dowdney seconded the motion. On the roll being called:
