**CALL TO ORDER**

After the Pledge of Allegiance, Fiscal Officer, Jennifer Haley, gave the roll call for the Board of Trustees. Present were: Mr. Dowdney and Mr. Sauls. Mr. Cornett was absent. Also present were Rex Parsons, Township Administrator and Denise Kelley, Zoning Administrator.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

*As part of Batavia Township's ongoing effort to recognize members of our business community, Mr. Parsons introduced Jason and Kelly Kellerman of Prestige Vehicles Corporation. It is*

located at 2030 State Route 125, Amelia and specializes in producing vehicles owned by funeral home businesses. Mr. Kellerman gave an overview of his business which began in 2007. Mr. Sauls, on behalf of the Batavia Township Board of Trustees, recognized Prestige Vehicle Corp. with a plaque of appreciation.

### **REPORTS OF THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR**

Mrs. Kelley gave her report. There were five house permits last month, 33 year-to-date, not including condominiums.

*Ms. Kelley presented Mr. Sheppard's violation report.* There were approximately 54 violation notices sent out, mostly property upkeep.

Ms. Kelley gave the reports for the Board of Zoning Appeals and Zoning Commission.

### **REPORTS OF THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR**

Mr. Parsons and Mr. Dowdney have met with Rumpke and CSI Republic concerning pricing and waste collection.

Mr. Parsons will coordinate a work day for the Trustees and general public to clear the Hike-Bike Trail.

Mr. Embry and Mr. Parsons met with the County and Village of Amelia concerning improvements to Church Street. Mr. Sauls motioned the Batavia Township Board of Trustees enter into an agreement with Amelia and Clermont County to improve Church Street. Mr. Dowdney seconded the motion. On the roll being called:

Mr. Parsons proposed the Trustees have a Township Yard Sale Days event in the fall.

Ohio Uniform Traffic Control Manual requires all agencies/governments must establish and implement a sign/maintenance program addressing minimum sign retro reflectivity requirements by January 2012. To check the township signs, the Township is borrowing a reflectivity machine from the Clermont County Engineers office. Wooden signs in some subdivisions will not be allowed and need to be replaced.

A resolution was previously passed not allowing door-to-door transient vendors in the Township. There was a recent transient vendor request. The Trustees agreed to deny this and uphold the resolution.

It is a type 2 expedited petition with only one property owner who signed the petition. There is no revenue loss to the township.

Committee Reports - Mr. Dowdney gave the report of the Union-Cemetery Committee. Grading is being performed making room for approximately 600 additional grave sites.

Mr. Sauls gave his report on the CJFED Committee.
